

# Girls Night Out Wine Bag

Free Knitting Pattern from [MomsBudget.com](http://MomsBudget.com). This fun gift bag is perfect for taking over for chick flick night with your girlfriends or as a gift bag for a wine lover.



**1 ball Patons Classic Wool in That's Pink**

**1 ball Patons Classic Wool in Black**

**5 mm circular needles in 16" length**

**5mm double pointed needles**

Cast on 68 stitches in pink with circular needles. Place needle marker, then join on the round when starting first row.

Row 1: K1, P1, repeat to end.

Row 2: P1, K1, repeat to end.

Repeat two row rib pattern for 13 more rows

Row 16: Knit

Continue knitting on the round, in the following pattern

Knit 4 rows in black

Knit 3 rows in pink

knit 2 rows in black

knit 4 rows in pink

knit 2 rows in black

Knit 8 rows in pink

Knit 3 rows in black

knit 3 rows in pink

Knit 6 rows in black

Knit 8 rows in pink

Knit 1 row in black

Knit 1 row in pink

Knit 2 rows in black

Knit 8 rows in pink

Knit 8 rows in black

Now, begin knitting the bottom in black, switching from circulars to double pointed needles when needed.

Edge row: K1, P1 to end (this will form the edge of bottom once felted)

Row 1: K15, k2tog, repeat to end (64 stitches)

Row 2: k6, k2tog, repeat to end (56 stitches)

Row 3: k26, k2tog, repeat to end (54 stitches)

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: k7, k2tog, repeat to end (48 stitches)

Row 6: Knit

Row 7: k6, k2tog, repeat to end (42 stitches)

Row 8: k17, k2tog, repeat to end (40 stitches)

Row 9: k6, k2tog, repeat to end (35 stitches)

Row 10: k5, k2tog, repeat to end (30 stitches)

Row 11: k4, k2tog, repeat to end (25 stitches)

Row 12: k3, k2tog, repeat to end (20 stitches)

Row 13: k8, k2tog, repeat to end (18 stitches)

Row 14: k2, k2tog, repeat to last two stitches, k2 (14 stitches)

Row 15: k1, k2tog, repeat to last two stitches, k2.

Leaving a long tale, use a needle to thread the tail through each of the remaining stitches, then tightening it closed. Tie off.

Wash in washing machine on hot water cycle to felt, checking on it throughout, but will likely need two washings for this wine bottle cover. Remove from washing machine, and shape over wine bottle and roll down the ribbed section halfway to form a cuff at the top. Allow to dry on wine bottle to retain shape while it dries.

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
