

Organic Cotton Coffee Sleeve

Rather than waste paper by using a cardboard coffee sleeve each time, knit your own coffee sleeve. And why not pamper your latte with organic coffee sleeve ☺ I have made other sleeves in the past, but they always felt scratchy, this one feels soft and cosy in your hands! This knits up super fast so you make many of these out of a single ball.

1 ball Patons Pure 100% organic cotton

(our sample is Neutral Beige #20011)

3.5mm / #4 knitting needles

Gauge: 21w x 34h on 3.5mm using stocking stitch.

Note: The needles are smaller than standard for this yarn, to prevent the sleeve from stretching after multiple uses/washes.

Instructions

Cast on 40 stitches.

Knit 2 rows

Row 3: K1, k into front and back of next stitch, knit to end of row.

Row 4: Same as row 3.

Row 5: knit

Row 6: purl

Repeat last two rows 7 more times.

Row 21: K1, k into front and back of next stitch, knit to end of row.

Row 22: Repeat row 21

Row 23 & 24: knit

Row 25: Cast off, leaving a long tail at end.

Sew edges together with long tail.

Enjoy it with your next latte!

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
